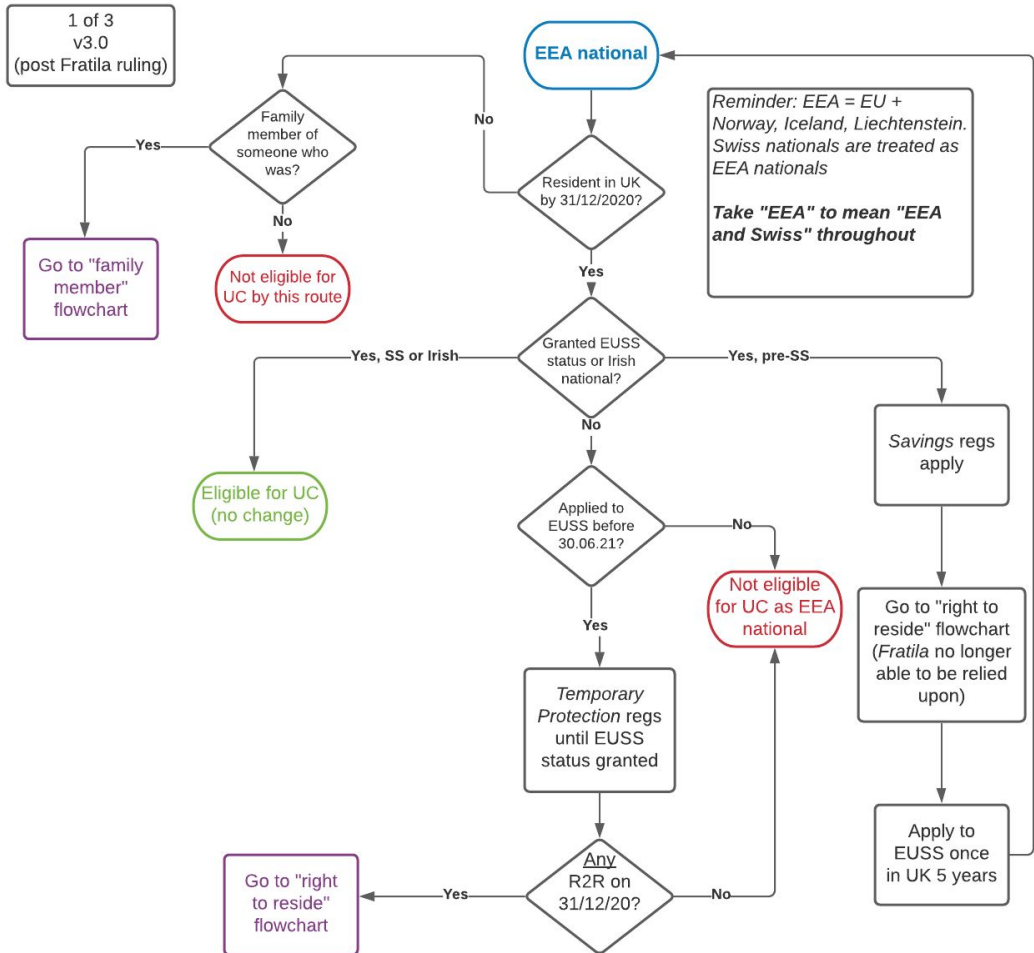

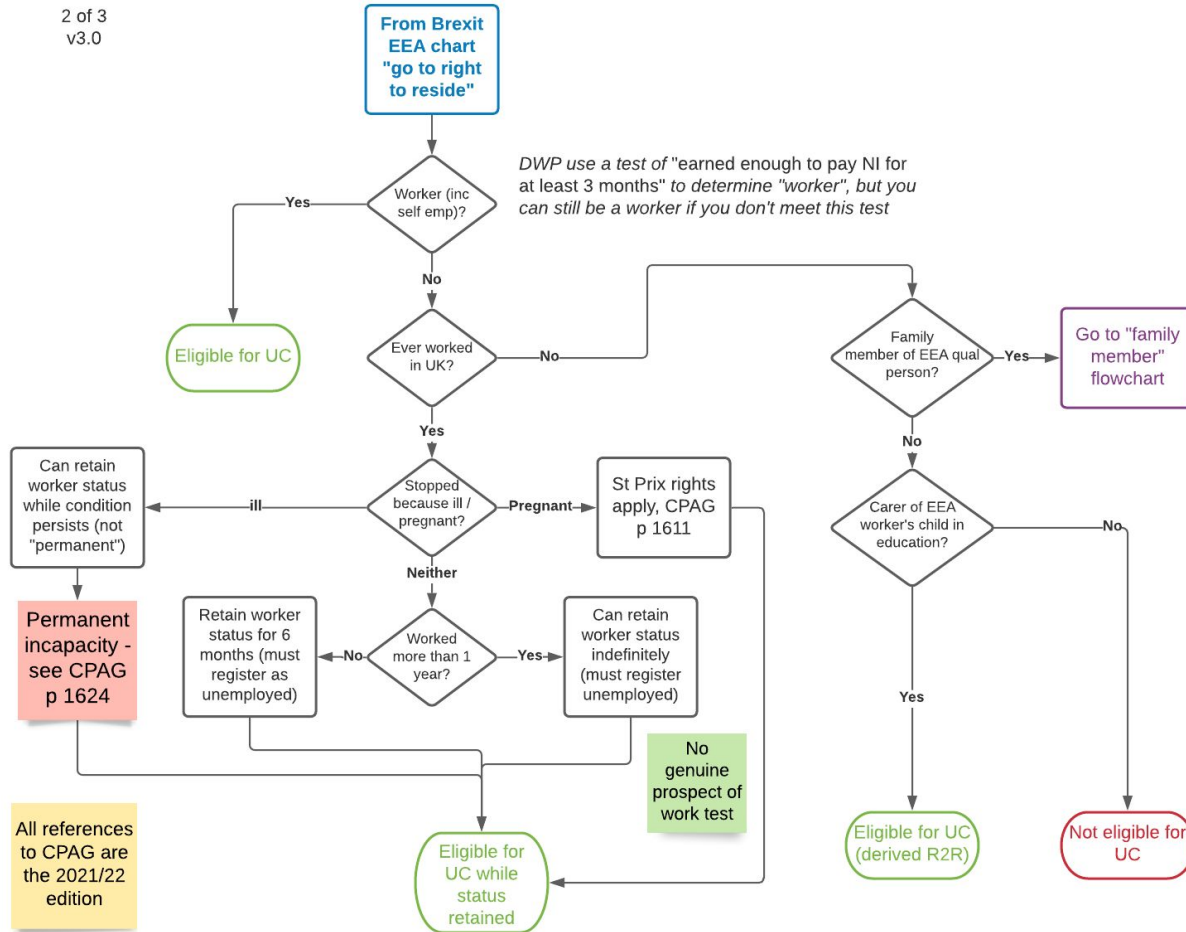

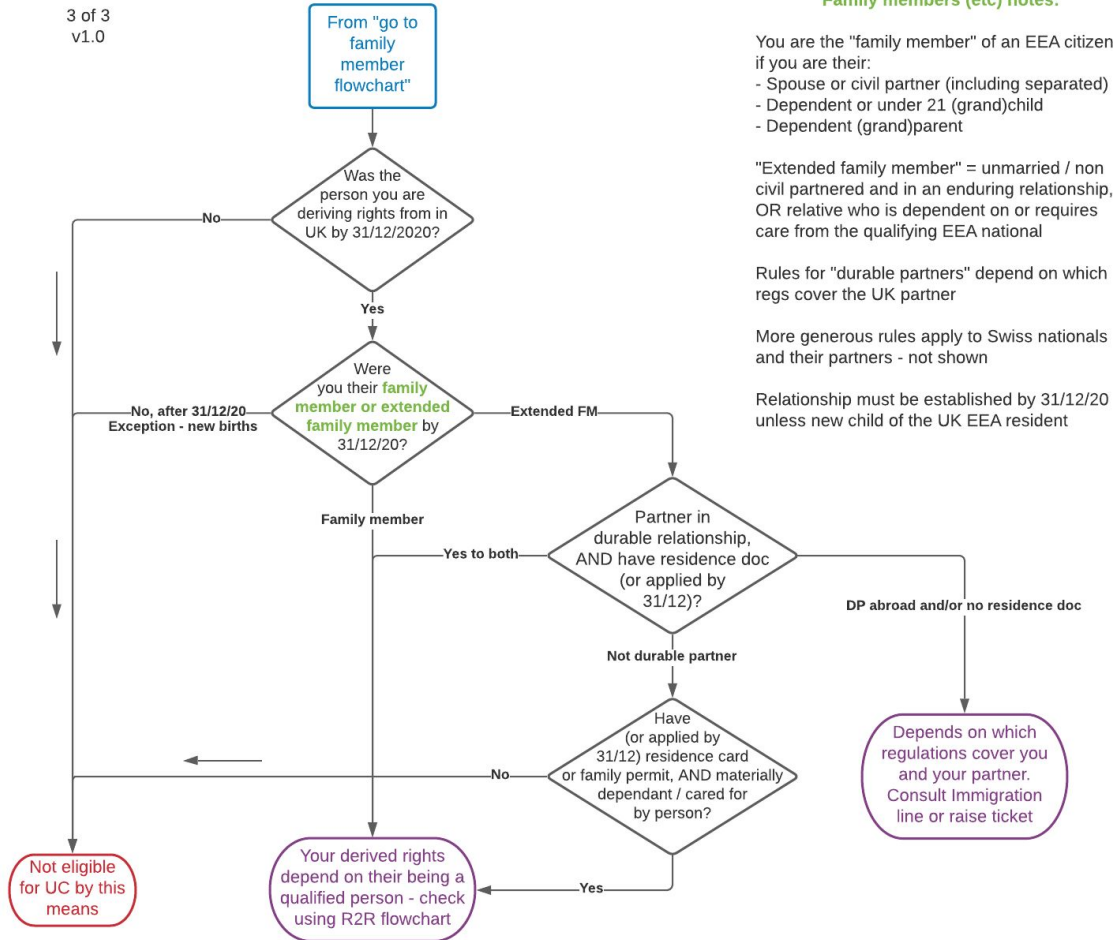

Family members (etc) notes:

You are the "family member" of an EEA citizen if you are their:

- Spouse or civil partner (including separated)
- Dependent or under 21 (grand)child
- Dependent (grand)parent

"Extended family member" = unmarried / non civil partnered and in an enduring relationship, OR relative who is dependent on or requires care from the qualifying EEA national

Rules for "durable partners" depend on which regs cover the UK partner

More generous rules apply to Swiss nationals and their partners - not shown

Relationship must be established by 31/12/20 unless new child of the UK EEA resident
